Congregations are encouraged to keep 25% of the offering for local ministries of peacemaking within the church and its community. 25% percent is used by presbyteries and synods and 50% is for the Presbyterian Peacemaking program. •# Pentecost - assists children at risk, youth and young adults. Congregations are encouraged to keep 40% of the offering to support ministry with children at risk in their communities.
